JAIL HOUSING FEES ORDINANCE:

An ordinance that enables the Municipal Judge to assess jail housing fees back to defendants on a case-by-case basis was submitted for Council approval.

MOTION: *Stivers* moved to approve the ordinance amending Section 9-116 of the Code of the City of Maize that relates to the sentencing of defendants found guilty of a violation of City ordinance and repealing the original section 9-116 of the Code of the City. *McCreath* seconded. Motion declared carried.
