As part of the Academy Arts District Project, RDG consultants originally provided the City with a cost estimate for the construction of an amphitheater in the amount of \$500,000. Since the April meeting, RDG updated their estimate to \$575,000 due to rising steel prices. Both the application and the CIP request has been adjusted to reflect this anticipated increase. This was a discussion item only; no action was taken.
